PHASE 2		
<b>A focused plus sample chooses error prone income applications to verify.</b> Error prone means that the total household income is within \$100 monthly or \$1200 annually of Income Eligibility Guidelines for free and reduced meals for that size household. Include applications where the Food Stamp and/or TANF number is provided by the applicant.
